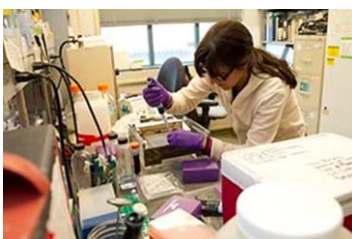


Did you know that the safety of your products might rest upon an understanding of how micro-organisms grow and contaminate?
